Every Body Athletics' mission is to make a lasting impact on the physical, social, and emotional wellbeing of adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (ID/DD) through inclusive group exercise. Using both individual and small group exercise activities involving physical and social instruction, EBA desires to provide adults with ID/DD the opportunity to achieve success and growth in both their physical and social fitness.

<u>Position Purpose</u>

EBA is looking for a passionate, driven college student (incoming junior or senior) to serve as the EBA Intern during the college summer break. At EBA, volunteer involvement is paramount, as they provide one-on-one support to athletes while promoting a fun, inclusive atmosphere. EBA's Intern plays a vital leadership role in our volunteer program, as s/he is the main point of contact for all student volunteers. The EBA Intern builds the volunteer schedule each month, provides ongoing communication and encouragement to volunteers, and also leads EBA School Ambassadors in their bimonthly meetings. S/he will also work closely with staff to help further develop EBA programming, plan for events, and complete other roles and tasks to serve adults with disabilities and their families.

A passion for disability, inclusion, and acceptance are critical qualities, as are positive leadership, organizational, and interpersonal skills.

Position Outcomes
